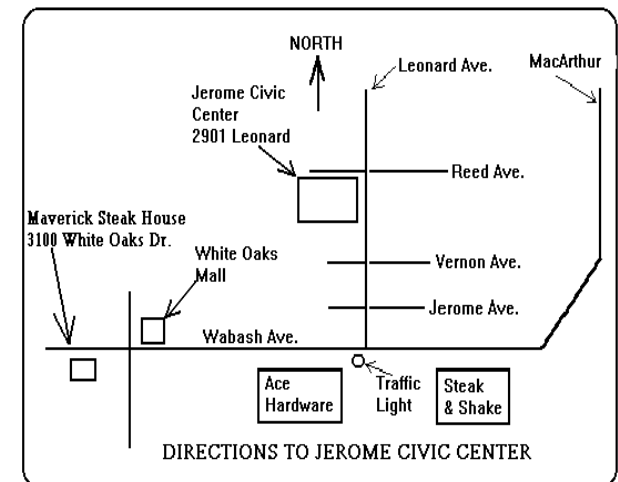
Saturday January 6th, 2007
