**A Woman of Faith and Her Message of Healing**

Born with cerebral palsy, Marlene learned to walk with braces by the time she was 5. At age 12, she gave her life to the Lord and became filled with the Holy Spirit a short time later. When she was 15, she suffered additional brain stem injuries causing severe seizures. Doctors tried to correct the problem with surgery but failed. Marlene finished High School and tried going to college but could not finish because of her deteriorating condition. Her health continued to worsen, leaving her a quadriplegic. Eventually she was sent to the Mayo Clinic in a life threatening coma. While in the hospital, Marlene cried out to God for help, like never before. A short time later, the Lord gave her a vision of the inside of a church she'd never seen before. In the vision, God revealed to Marlene he would heal her body on March 29th.

On that exact day, Marlene got to the Church she'd seen in the vision. Following a series of humorous events, the Lord God restored Marlene to health on March 29th, 1981, just as he promised. Marlene has shared her story on the **700 Club**, TBN's **Praise the Lord**, and the **Sid Roth Program**. She has also spoken in several churches through out the U.S. Marlene is presently co-owner of a busy floral shop named "**Heaven's Scent**" in Republic Missouri. Marlene describes herself as healthy, active and extremely grateful. She boldly proclaims "**God is alive and well!**"
