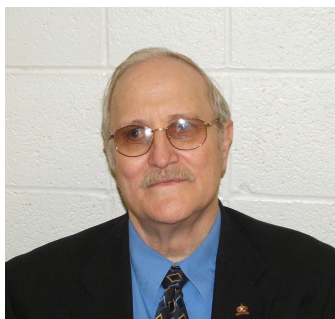

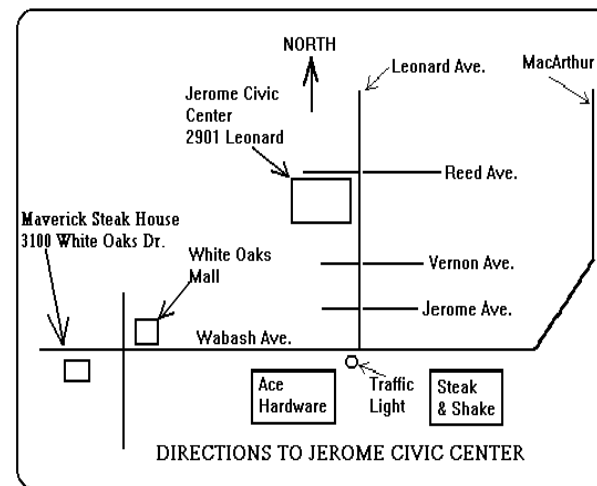


Chapter Events
