You're invited to spend an evening with Steve and his wife Betty, as they share a part of their lives and what God has done.

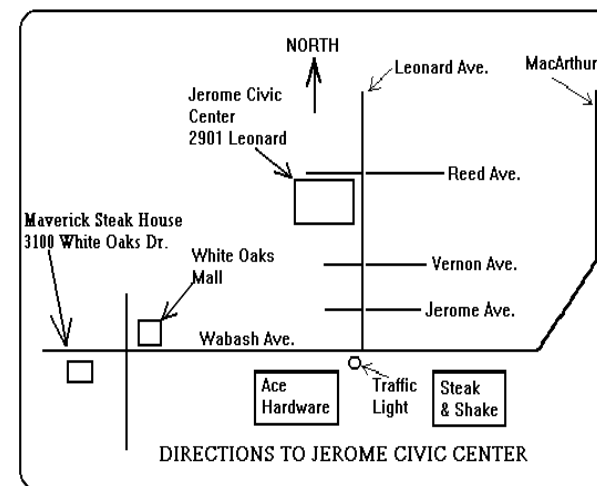
Chapter Events
