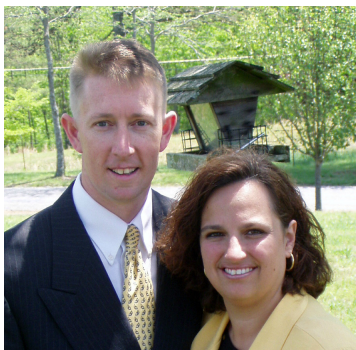

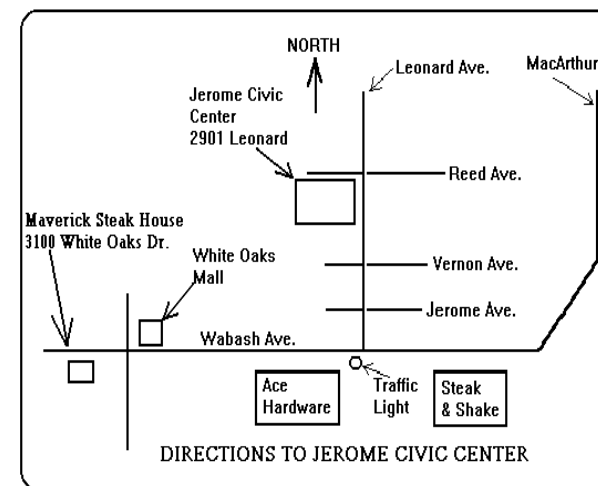
Saturday December 2nd, 2006
