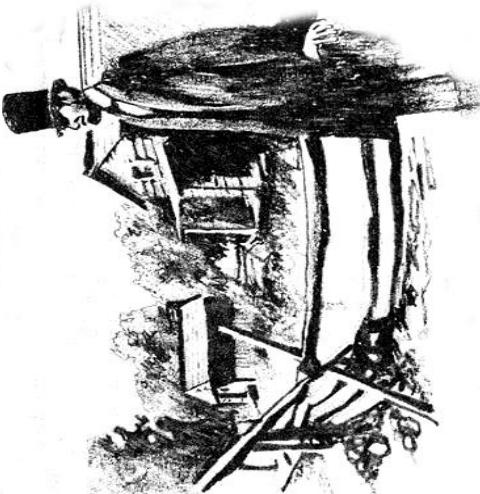
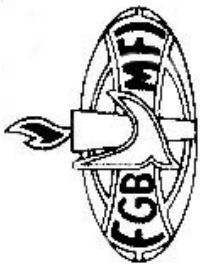

Jerry finally went to the doctor to have the growth removed from his lower lip. I'd been there for years, kinda looked like a wart. He'd picked it off several times only to have it grow back. The doctor looked at it along with several other spots, took biopsies and sent them to a lab. A few days later Jerry was called back to the doctor. That was when the doc dropped the bomb on Jerry by saying all the spots were melanoma cancers and needed surgery immediately. He had spots on his eyelids, nose, left ear, left arm and lower lip. Jerry's surgeon sent him to his family doctor to test him to see if he could handle the surgery. Jerry physician ran several blood tests, only to have them come back with problems. A few days later, he was called back to the second physicians office. His family doctor told Jerry there was good news and bad news. Jerry opted for the good news first. The doc told Jerry he would not need all that surgery. Now for the bad news, Jerry... you have liver cancer, and you'll be dead in a month. Jerry had been feeling bad for quite a while, but thought it was because he was working 2 full time jobs, and sleeping only 3 to 4 hours a day. He'd been a civilian employee with the Missouri Highway Patrol for over 21 years, and ran his own furniture business on the side.

Given the news, Jerry resigned to go home and die. Although Jerry felt very sick, he tried to keep his furniture business going to feed his family until his life insurance kicked in after his death. Jerry still went to church each week to do God a favor, like many of us do. There was plenty of religion, but no relationship. Jerry found himself thinking a lot about his future. Like where he might be spending his time. Eternity to be exact. One day he asked the elders to anoint him with oil and pray for healing. The Lord spoke up and reminded Jerry that He'd healed him 2000 years ago and told him to confess his healing to everyone. But he didn't look healed. I didn't feel healed, I was very sick. I got down to 87 pounds, I was so skinny, I only had one side. The Lord showed me Psalms 103: 2-3, and Romans 4:17, telling me to call things which be not as though they were. My body soon began to respond to the word of God without any cancer treatments. The cancers were disappearing, my eyes were healed, my hearing returned, my knees healed in that order. God told me he'd given me a ministry of healing and evangelism. Sure enough, God's word is true. We have literally seen thousands of miraculous healings by God's hand of grace. Blind eyes healed, deaf ears opened, lepers healed, broken backs healed, coma's broken. God even raised a lady from the dead in 1996, and she is still living. Jerry's wife Jenny is mainly responsible for Jerry coming to the Lord through her examples. Jerry and Jenny have been given a ministry of reconciliation of broken hearts and bodies to the Lord. Jerry knows first hand that God is no respecter of persons. What he'll do for Jerry, he'll do for you. he loves you more than you'll ever imagine. He wants to set you free and heal your body. 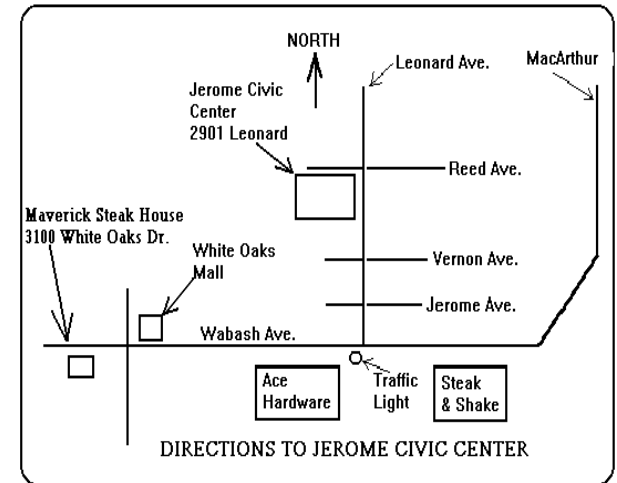


Chapter Events
